Fort Wainwright (FWA) and the City of Fairbanks, Alaska Partnership: Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) Services

- ✓ Agreement Type: IGSA
- ✓ Partnership Benefits:
 - Faster response
 - Better emergency tracking
 - Expanded coverage area

Partnership Description

- Partnership with City of Fairbanks to access CAD system.
- Supports safety on FWA/training areas and Mutual Aid Agreements. Routes on-post mobile 911 directly to the FWA dispatch center (previously sent to City).

Partnership Development Process

- Directorate of Emergency Services (DES) and the Plans, Analysis and Integration Office (PAIO) worked directly with the City of Fairbanks to establish this agreement. Process was long (18 months) but resulted in a one-time cost savings of \$283,000.



Partnership in Action

- Challenges include delays in renovation of new dispatch facility and the installation, configuration, and testing of Alaska Public Safety Information Network (APSIN), Motorola, and Airbus Workstations. Additionally, FWA is working to equip vehicles with computers and connectivity to use CAD information.
